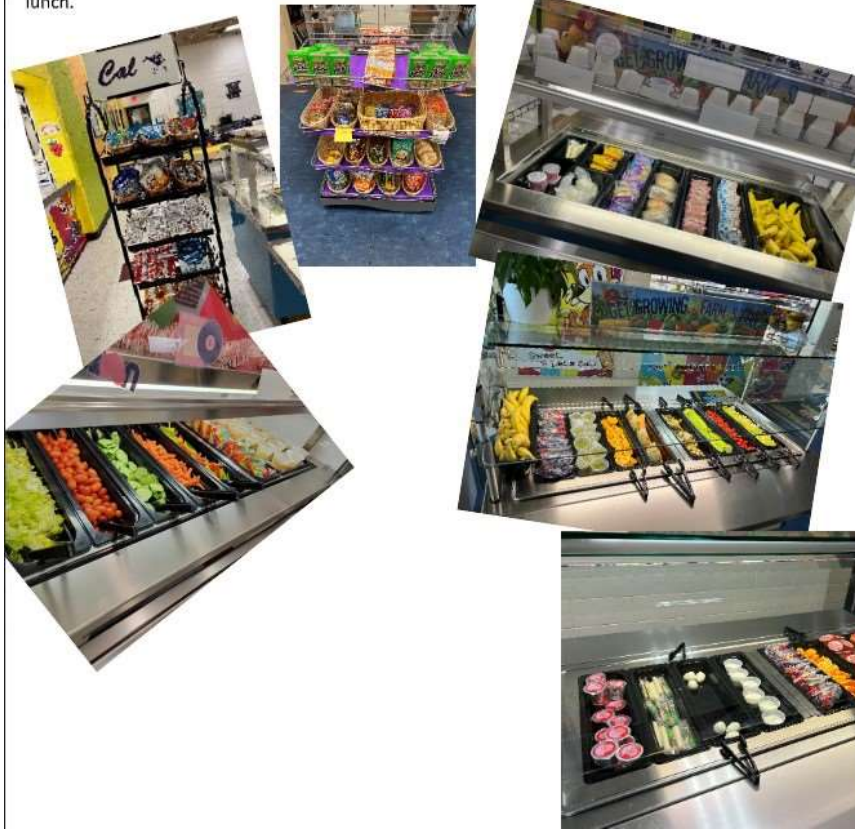

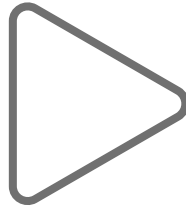
Volunteer Management Program
