Dear Caledonia Community Schools community,

At this time, CCS continues to follow the Kent County Health Department (KCHD) [Public Health Order executed on August 6, 2021](#), as it pertains to isolation and quarantine requirements well as the [KCHD School & Childcare Toolkit](#) and [KCHD K-12 Symptom and Testing Protocol](#) (both published on December 17, 2021). We recognize MDHHS has recently provided [new guidance](#) for educational settings, and we anticipate that KCHD will release new guidance for the educational setting soon based on MDHHS information. **Until the district receives an updated order and/or toolkit from KCHD, we will continue to follow the current KCHD isolation and quarantine guidelines.**

**As a reminder, the federal mass transportation rule requiring individuals to wear a mask on a school bus is still in effect (until March 18th, 2022) and has not changed.** As stated in previous communications, we will continue to work with public health officials and make the necessary adjustments to our policy based on local health departments (Allegan and Kent), Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS), and CDC guidance.

We appreciate your patience and support as we navigate these ongoing changes.
