The good news is, we've had no new cases of COVID-19 at Caledonia Community Schools since our last update. As a result, we've been cleared to restart in-person instruction at the High School this Monday, Sept. 14. In addition, athletic teams can begin practicing on Saturday, Sept. 12.

Like you, we are looking forward to welcoming our amazing students back to the classroom. We thank the Caledonia Schools Community for coming together to help slow the spread of COVID-19 and your patience and understanding while we made the quick transition to virtual learning.

During the last two weeks, we've identified several areas of improvement regarding our virtual instruction. We've implemented an instructional schedule that allows for independent learning and two-way communication between teacher and student. Whether in the classroom or learning online we know relationships are essential to learning, so we're also excited to announce we're adding additional online teacher mentors to help support our full-time online learners moving forward.
