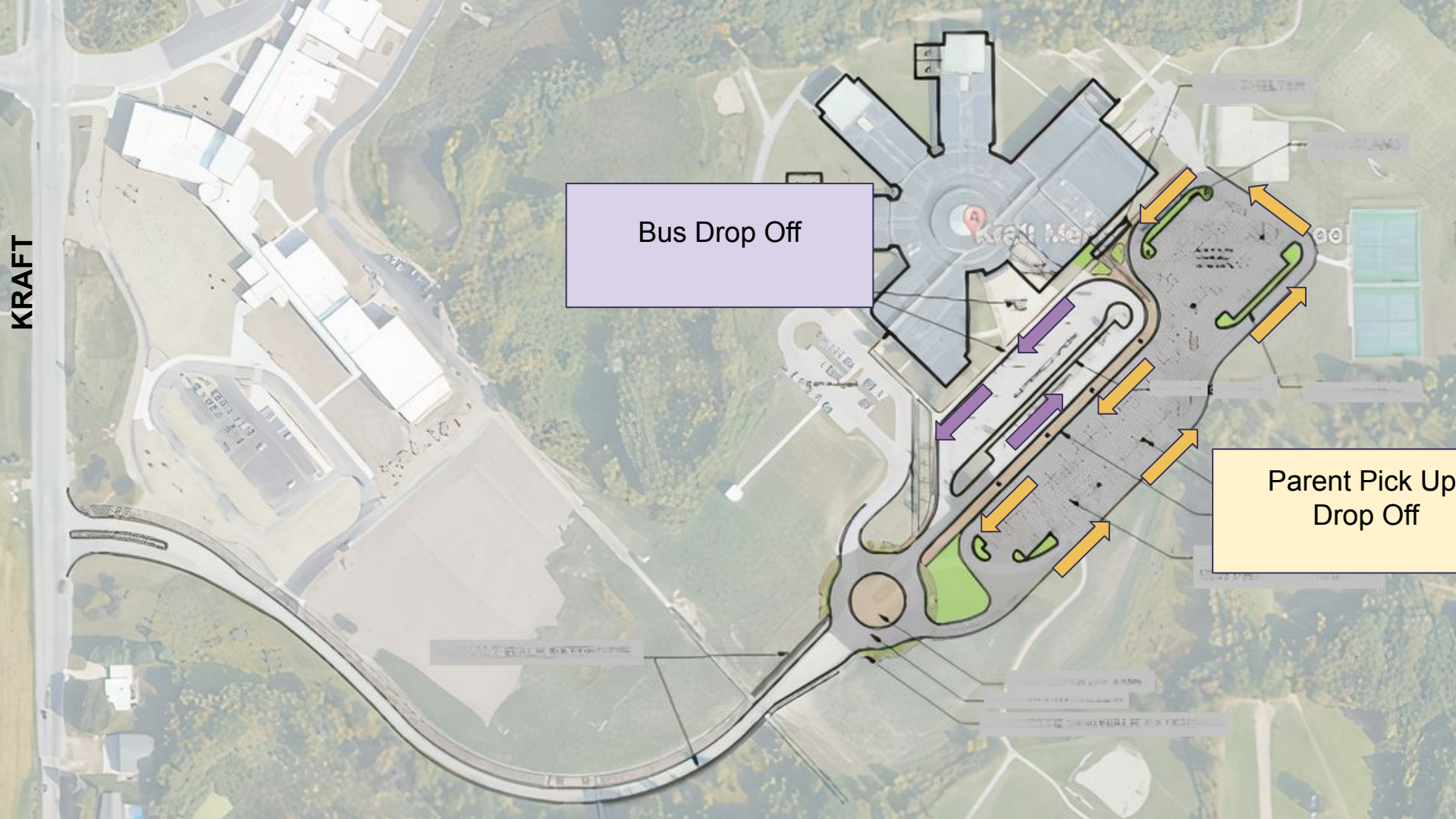
KMIS - Building Changes (Bond)

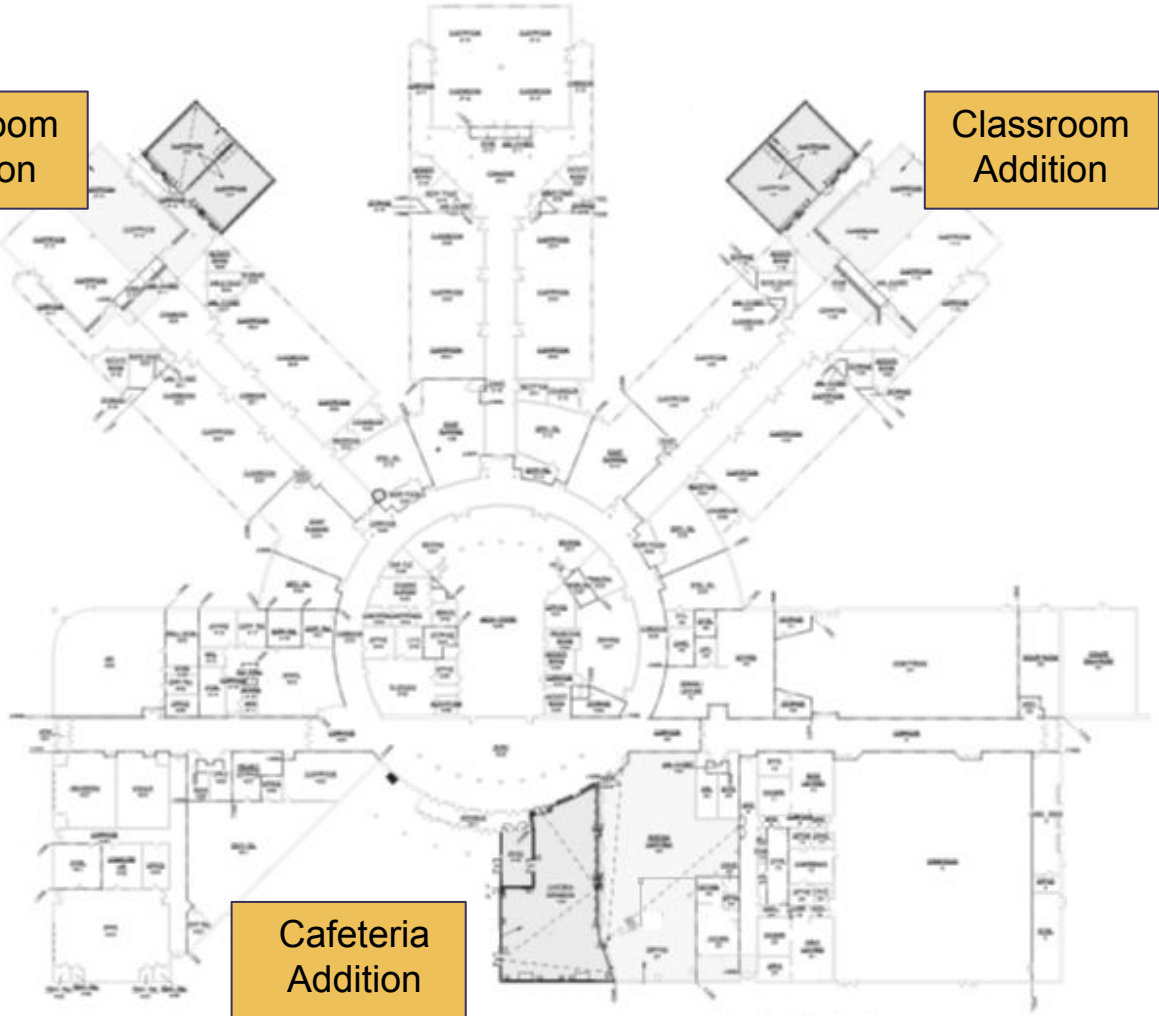

Proposed - Condensed work at Emmons Lake Elementary:

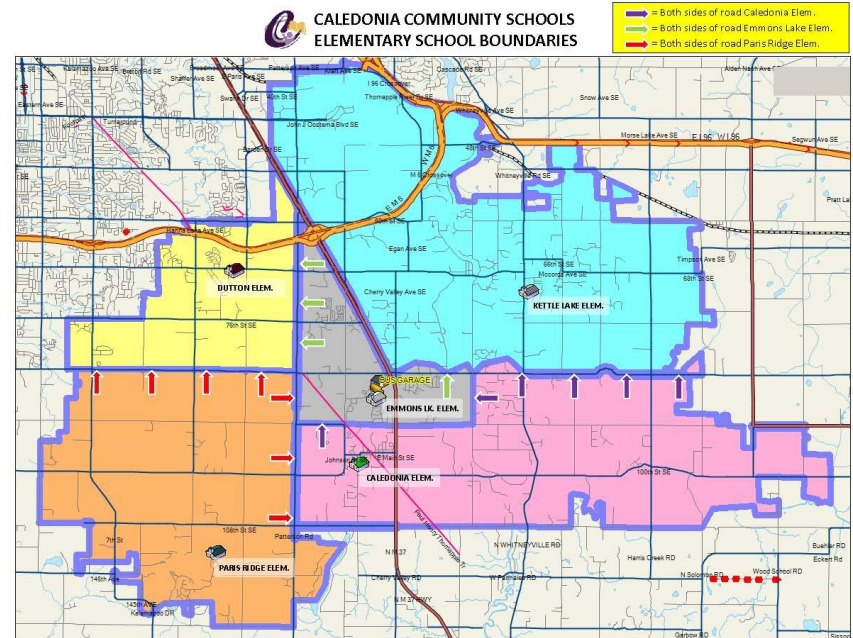
- Repave asphalt parking lot - **Summer 2021**
