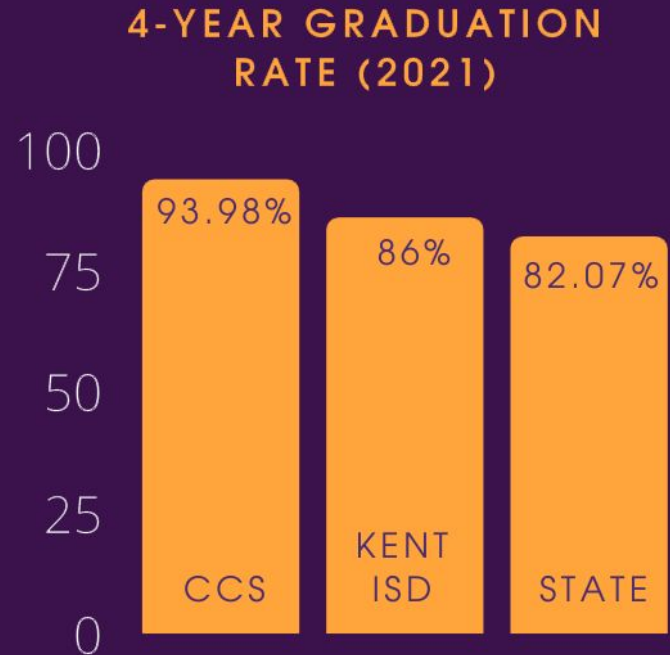

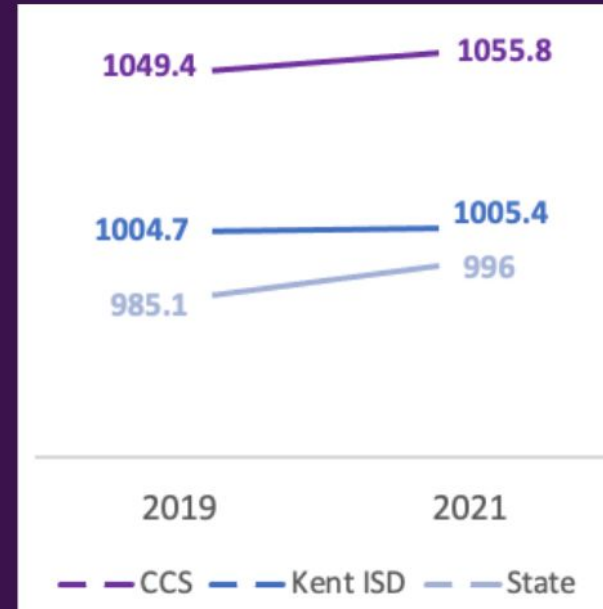

SAT SCORES (2019 & 2021)

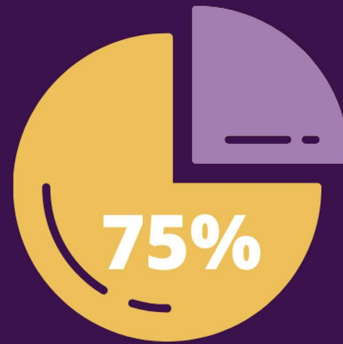

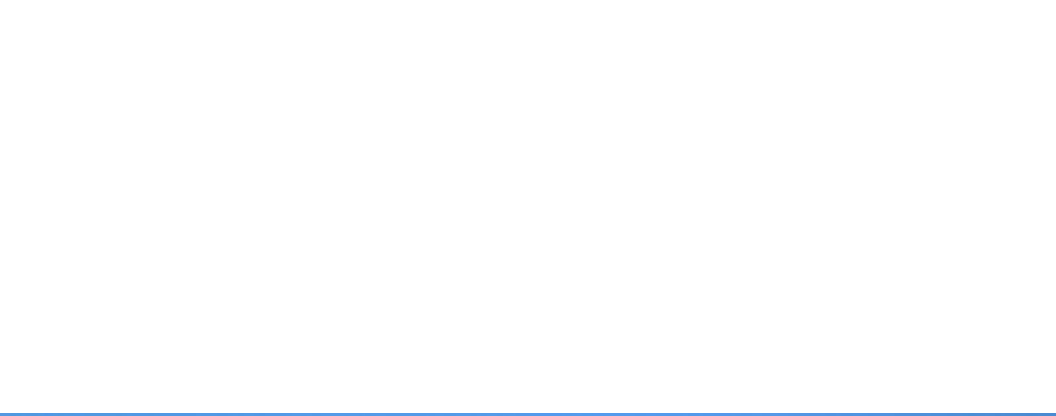

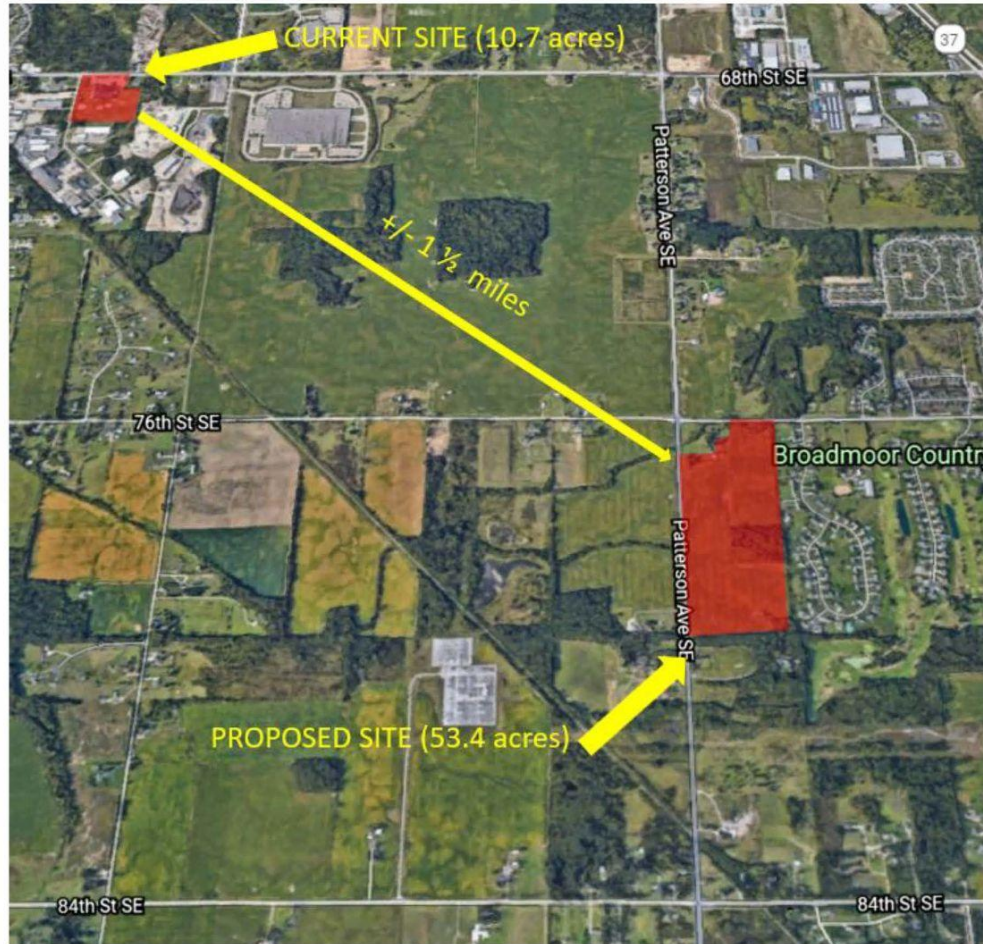
