Things you should know ...



School Hours:

Start of Day: 8:45 am ~ End of Day: 3:40 pm
(Students may not be dropped off before 8:40 am*)

*Breakfast starts at 8:30am

Half-Day Dismissal: 12:00 pm

Parent Drop Off/Pick Up: (see procedure here)

To keep everyone safe, please be kind and follow the rules for parent drop off and pick up. If you need to exit your vehicle for whatever reason, you must park your car.

End of day changes:

All end of day routine changes must be called into the office before 2:30pm.

Pick up Number assigned in the Office:

If you plan on picking up your student after school on a routine bases, please be sure you have a pick up number. You can pick one up in the office. If you already have one assigned from last year, that number is good until you no longer has children attending Emmons Lake. If you have misplaced your number, please contact the office.

Calling in an Absence or Running Late:

If your child will be absent or late for whatever reason, it is IMPORTANT that you contact us first thing in the morning, preferably before 8:30am. You can call the office or email the teacher and both secretaries (andreanon@calschools.or & roycea@calschools.org.). Please provide the reason why your child will be late or absent. This saves the office from having to call you back;)

Volunteers:

All volunteers must have a current background check on file with the district and need to renew each school year. Forms are available in the office or online, under <u>Volunteers</u>. Fill out pages 9 & 10 and return to the office with a copy of the front side of your drivers license. Please allow at least 14 days for the office to process your forms.

Health Concerns:

Please make sure the school is aware of any health or medical concerns you may have regarding your child. If your child will need any medication while they are at school, we must have a form filled out and ALL medication must be brought in by an adult. Student's are not allowed to carry medication to and from school.

Extra Clothing:

If your student is accident prone, it is always a good idea to send in an extra set of cloths. We try to have extra in the office, but it goes out fast and usually isn't returned.

******Label Label - all of your child's belongings******

If their things go missing, it is so much easier for us to return it back to your child.
