

Notes from the Nurse:

Just a reminder that medications that need to be taken at school must be brought to the school's main office by an adult. It should never be in a student's backpack or lunch box.

Any medications taken during school hours must have: Prescription medications require a doctor's signature. Medication must be in the original bottle/prescription bottle with a label attached.

Parent/guardian signature must be on the medication order form. <u>(medication forms can be found here).</u>

In order to Self-Carry Medications:
The doctor must sign the self-carry section of the medication form. The self-carry medication must be approved by the District nurse.

Self-carry medications (medications that must be carried by the student, not in a backpack or locker), per district policy, are emergency medications such as inhalers, epinephrine pens, and diabetes medications.
