It has been another successful week starting off the year! Students are doing so well with getting into routines, learning expectations, and helping one another! I continue to be impressed with their enthusiasm and ability to focus during these first two weeks.

This week we started our fall diagnostic tests: Acadience and iReady. We use the Acadience test to determine student reading skills in the areas of Phonological Awareness, Phonics, Accuracy, Fluency, and Comprehension. Additionally, the iReady Assessment covers both reading and math. Teachers use these assessments to help determine small groups based around similar student needs along with monitoring growth over larger periods of time. Will take these assessments again in December and late spring.

Each month this year we will focus on a different theme. During September our school-wide conversation will be on empathy. We will talk about what it means to be empathetic, challenge students to showcase empathy, and discuss how it fits in with who we strive to be everyday as Paris Ridge Panthers!

It has been an amazing couple of weeks. I hope you have a nice Labor Day weekend and a chance to spend time as a family!


